## COMPETITION UNIFORM POLICY

## 1. Purpose

Camden \& District Netball Association (C\&DNA) believes that our netball courts should be a friendly and welcoming space for all and believe that uniform options should encourage participation and enjoyment for everyone. The introduction of flexible playing and umpire uniforms is aimed at ensuring players and umpires feel comfortable whilst participating in Netball activities. This document guides Affiliated Clubs in aligning their uniform policies with that of C\&DNA's.

## 2. Scope

C\&DNA have introduced flexibility around playing and umpire uniforms. Each Affiliated Club may choose any combination of the following to play in a competition game. The choice must be consistent throughout the club.

Playing uniforms must be in keeping with the club's registered playing uniform. The uniform is defined by the club and approved by the Executive Committee.

## 3. Players Uniform Guidelines

a) Club playing dress is to be in club colours and design as approved by the Executive Committee
b) Short and long $T$-shirts must be the same design as the top of the playing dress
c) Short and long T-shirts must be able to accommodate Velcro attached playing positional bibs
d) Sports shorts are to be in a block colour that matches the club uniform colours
e) Clubs must maintain the same design and colour across all teams
f) Leggings are allowed and must be consistent with the club colours across all club teams
g) Players and match officials (umpires) may wear head coverings for religious reasons, provided they are:
I. Made of soft material
II. Tight and non-flowing. Edges must be securely held by tape or tucked into shirts
III. Not cover positional bibs
IV. Not tied on or fastened by clips or pins
V. Be all black, all white or club colours
h) Head coverings should be included as an item in all affiliated club's playing uniforms for the competition

## 4. Match Officials (Umpires)

Match officials (umpires) must wear clothing that is distinct from the teams playing uniform including suitable sports footwear
a) White dress/white shorts with a short or long-sleeved white t-shirt
b) Club playing uniform with a short or long-sleeved white t-shirt
c) Club leggings with a short or long-sleeved white t-shirt
d) Sports shorts in block colour to match the club colours with a short or long-sleeved white $t$-shirt
